The first outing of the year will be on **FRIDAY, MAY 26th** with a 6 pm shotgun start. The event will be a 9-hole, 4-person (two couples to a team) scramble. You may make your own team and we will be taking the first 18 teams to sign up for the outing.

Following golf, the clubhouse staff will be hosting a Dinner as part of the evening. Cost for the event will be **\$55 per couple**, which includes the golf, cart, prizes and the meal. A reminder, the money allocated to the meal portion of your entry fee is applied to your yearly food minimum.

The tournament will have two divisions for competition. The A Division will consist of players with handicaps of 0-7.9 USGA. The B Division is 8.0 and up USGA handicaps. The lowest handicap on your team determines your division.
